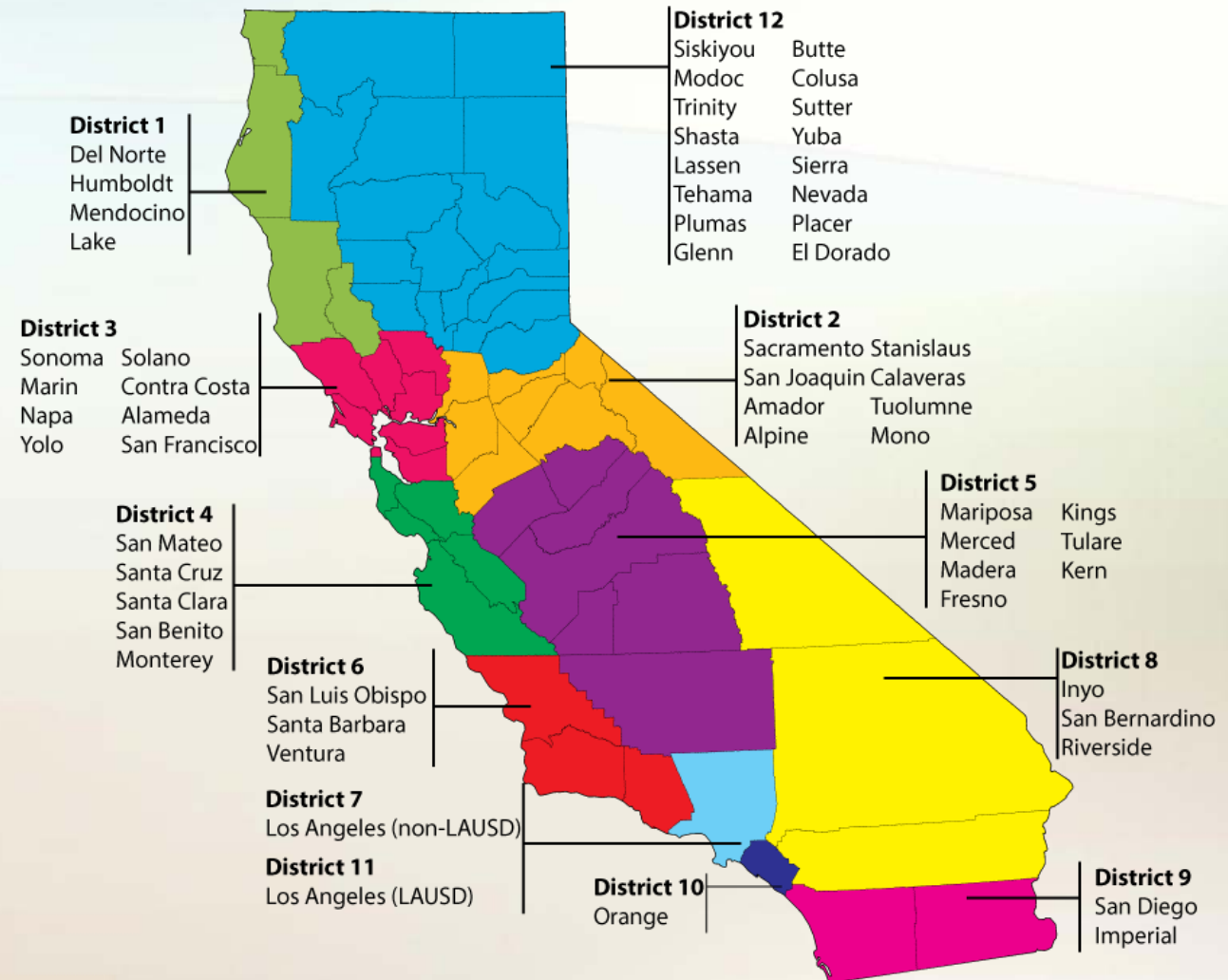

Meeting the Needs of Students

Continuation high schools meet the needs of students:

- aged 16 years or older
- who have not graduated from high school, are at risk of not graduating
- are not exempt from compulsory school attendance.



Model Continuation High School (MCHS) Recognition Program

(MCHS) is a partnership between the California Department of Education and the California Continuation Education Association.



MCHS Recognition Program

- MCHS identifies and recognizes outstanding continuation high schools and creates a resource list for school visits.
- MCHS schools provide comprehensive services to at-risk youth through the use of exemplary instructional strategies, flexible scheduling and guidance and counseling services.



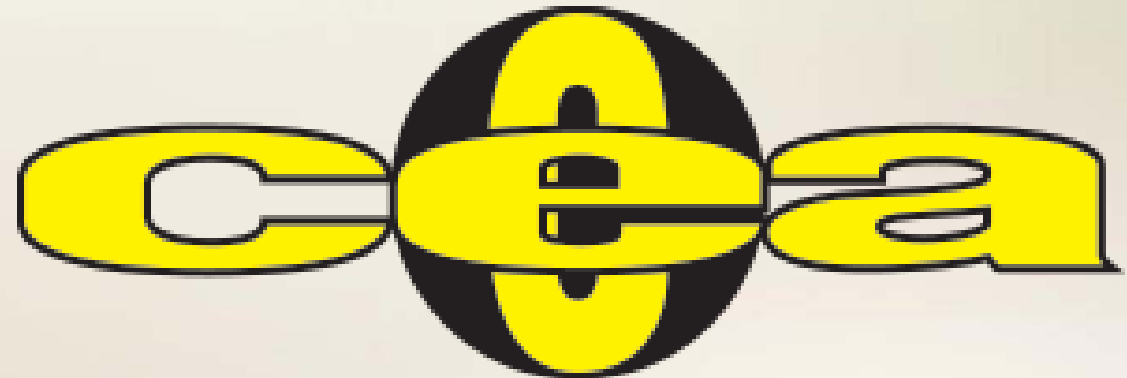

who are getting in trouble are going to. When my son Josh said he wanted to transfer to Bowman in February of 2015, I wasn't in any rush to let him. I suggested that because he only had a few months left to graduate that he imply take care of what needed to be done to make that happen. A month later, he brought it up again. I asked him to gather information about the school knowing the likelihood of him following through was slim and he would just "do what he needed to do where he was" to finish his senior year of high school. Unfortunately, with two months left of his senior year, my son chose to stop attending high school.

What do I know about Bowman High School? I received a call from Bowman High School following up with students who left the district to offer options for completion if needed. The timing was perfect for my son, as he was not successful with his other efforts and was motivated to attend. A simple proactive outbound call from Bowman impacted my family in such a positive way.

What do I know about Bowman High School? They are not just that school that all the kids who get into trouble go to. They are much more than that; a school that has options for kids who might not be fitting into the predetermined guidelines of the standard high schools. Bowman had options and clearly set guidelines to help my son, holding him accountable while showing him that they were committed to his success in obtaining a high school diploma. Devastatingly, Josh died before he was able to complete his remaining credits, but he was close.

What do I know about Bowman High School? They are a school that should be known for their compassion and understanding that some needs might be messy. After losing Josh, the staff made sure we knew about his efforts by highlighting key areas of his work and drawing attention to areas in which he mentioned his family. They made a point to tell us about his character and how he was viewed by the staff and his peers.

What do I know about Bowman High School? They seemed to know my son better than the school he had attended for years prior. They knew my son for one month and were present at his memorial service, and expressed their intent to present a diploma for him because he was so close to finishing.

What do I know about Bowman High School? They are a school that I can trust with my daughter Rayanne. When the larger, traditional high school was no longer the best fit for her, I knew Bowman was. She did not go to Bowman because she was one of those kids who were getting in trouble. Her life happened to get complicated in a way that made Bowman a better option. Its environment of less students, a staff of caring and dedicated people and a structure with resources to address the sometimes messiness of life was an option for us and I am thankful for that.

Three months have passed since Rayanne began attending Bowman and I can't help but reach out to thank the staff for their part in her getting some "spark" back. There is a marked difference in her attitude and commitment. He is talking about future college plans and career options. Her life changed when she lost her brother, her thoughts became different and she needed to be in a place where there was more focus on the importance of fostering that aspect of life. Thank you to all who take the time to consider the kids who attend this school in a way that gets closer to meeting their needs.

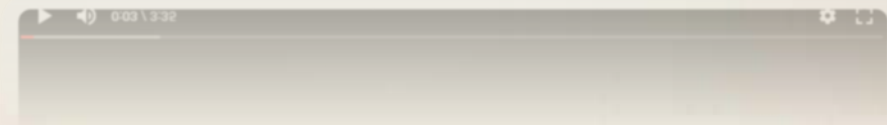
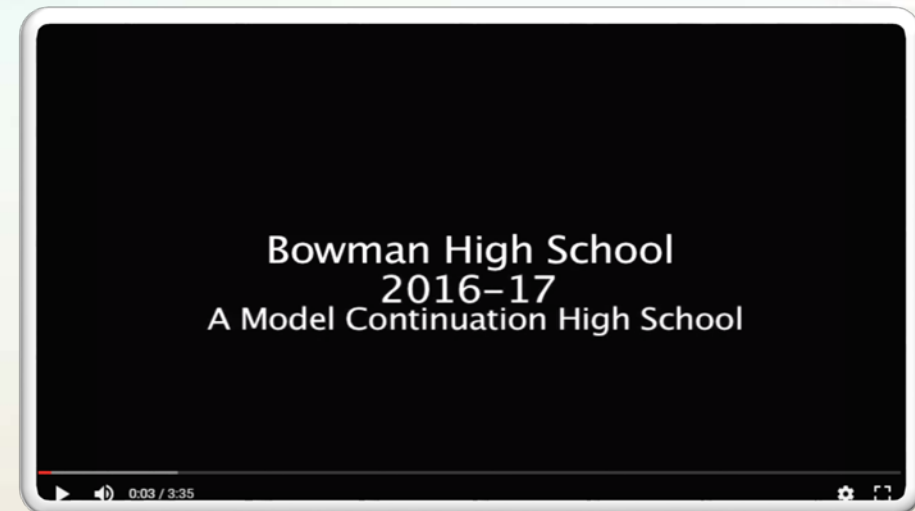
