2017-2019


Services/Materials to include the following:

- ◆ Repository (padfolio/electronic portfolio) for Administrative Candidate
- ◆ Candidate access to Induction Support
- ◆ Leadership and liaison between Hart Induction Program and Newhall District including Support Collaboratives, Orientations and Training provided by ACSA & CNET
- ◆ Hart district serving as liaison between Newhall and CTC (Cluster and State levels)
- ◆ Both access to registration for five academies/cohorts and opportunities to produce a transcript of course offerings
- ◆ Seminars leading to clearing of preliminary credential, including advisement, portfolio analysis and seminars
- ◆ Analysis of induction credentials by Induction Director and Hart Credentials Analyst to determine recommendation for Clear credential
- ◆ Recommendation of Clear credential upon satisfactory completion of requirements for CASC Induction Inquiry system
- ◆ Fee Schedule as follows:

2017-2018	Administrative Candidates charged at \$3000 (to be paid by administrative candidate in June 2018)
2018-2019	Administrative Candidates charged at \$3000 (to be paid by administrative candidate in June 2019)


Newhall School District to provide the following:

 - NOTE: Administrative Coach must follow same procedures for selection as all administrative coaches in the Hart Induction CASC Program




