V.A. Board Member Reports

Mr. Peschek outlined the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act, which streamlines the bid process for public works projects. This public contract code provides alternative bid limits that allow for more flexibility and for projects to proceed in a more timely manner through a process similar to the prequalification process the District currently uses. Mr. Peschek pointed out differences between formal and informal bidding processes, and explained that the same dollar limits will apply to maintenance projects. When questioned about change orders, Mr. Peschek confirmed there is a \$45,000 limit on change orders, and if there were extenuating circumstances that required increases beyond that amount, they would need to be presented separately for Board approval.

Mr. Sturgeon said he would like Administrative Regulation 3311 - Bids adjusted to state that all qualified vendors will be invited to give quotes. He also asked that if a vendor with the lowest quote is not chosen, the reasoning behind that decision be explained to the Board.
