### Impact of Reading

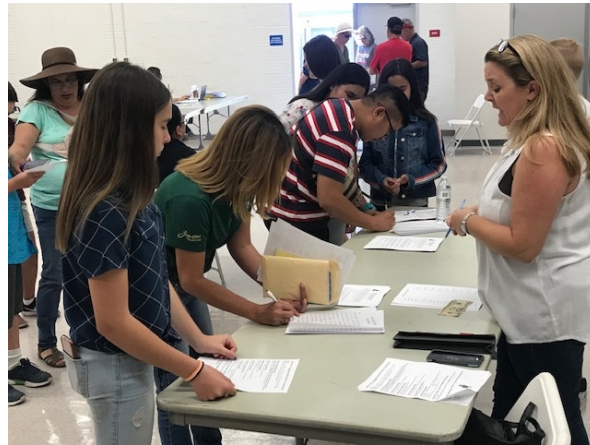

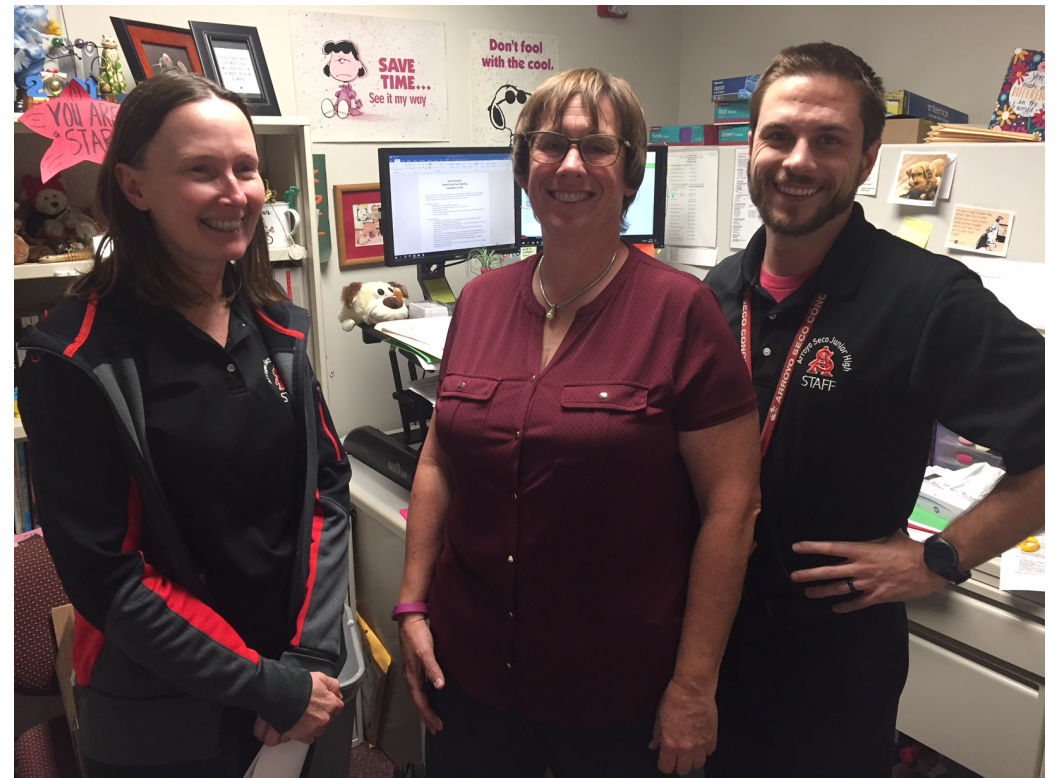
