Prompt Attention to All Inquiries & Correspondence Quick response to inquiries and correspondence is essential. Important points of phone conversations should be documented in project binder and confirmed in letterform.

Change of Key Client Personnel During the Design Process If any key station personnel change during the conceptualizing process of a design, a holding period should take place and all designs and schedules shall be re-evaluated.

Notification of Delays The station project coordinator will notify BDI of any possible delays due to non-completion of station responsibilities concerning the project.

AGREEMENT

OTHER PAYMENT CONDITIONS

Additional Time

Client will pay Designer, One Hundred Fifty Dollars, (\$150.00), per hour or fraction thereof, plus Designer's out of pocket expense for any design changes requested by Client after design acceptance.

Reimburse Miscellaneous Project Expenses

Client will reimburse Designer for incidental project expenses such as reproductions, blueprints, postage, long distance phone charges, handling of drawings and specifications, etc., and miscellaneous transportation, overnight shipping and living expenses while in travel status. Client will reimburse Designer for any unforeseen services or materials approved by Client.

Overtime Charges Due to Missed Deadlines

The project price is based on the Client's prompt delivery to Designer of required items (such as artwork, negatives for duratrans, equipment specifications, etc.) on or before established deadlines. Client agrees to pay any overtime and rush charges due to Client failure to meet specified deadlines.

Interest Due for Past Due Accounts

Payments due the Designer under this Agreement shall bear interest at the legal rate commencing thirty (30) days after billing date.

Ownership of Materials

All designs furnished under this contract are and shall remain the exclusive copyrighted property of Designer. Client shall not permit said designs to be used in any other market, or re-use for any other purpose by Client or any other person without the express written consent of Designer and the payment of compensation thereof.

AGREEMENT MODIFICATIONS

Modifications in Writing

This agreement may be amended by mutual written consent of both Designer and Client. All terms and conditions not specifically amended will prevail for the balance of the project. It is mutually understood that any changes in project scope may require schedule adjustments.

Increases in Project Scope

The project scope may be increased if Client approves a written change order describing the additional materials or services and corresponding payment. Client will return a signed change order copy to Designer and pay the change order amount in full before additional materials or services are furnished.

Reductions in Project Scope

Any project reductions (materials or services deleted) desired by Client after design acceptance must be requested in writing by Client and submitted to Designer for approval. Client agrees to pay Designer for any completed work in progress to that point plus a 25% restocking fee for all deleted items.

ATTORNEY'S FEES

If either party commences a legal action to enforce any of the terms of this contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.

CONTRACT IN ENTIRE

This contract sets forth all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties. Only those items described in the "Professional Services"/Cost Breakdown sections are included in this project. Any oral representations by either party that are not included herein are not legally binding.

GOVERNING LAW

This contract is entered into by Designer in San Diego County, California and is to be governed by the laws of The State of California. Any suit to enforce the provisions of this contract may be brought in San Diego County, California.

FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Designer nor the Client shall be liable to the other for the non-performance of its obligations hereunder due to any event of "force majeure", including but not limited to, fire, flood, earthquake, explosion, act of God, equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, war, any government law, or regulation, court order, or other cause not reasonably within the control of the non-performing party.

FINAL DOCUMENTATION

Client agrees to provide Designer with a video tape of the premiere newscast as well as approximately 5 minutes of video of the set completely lighted with no talents on set. Video to include full 180-degree pan, wide shots, cross shots, and detail shots. The Client also agrees to provide Designer with high-resolution digital photos taken by a professional photographer of left, center, and right wide shots, and close-ups of the various elements.
