Targeted Parent and Family Engagement Practices



- 9th-Grade Push-In Intervention Model: weekly phone calls, homework calendar sent via remind app, weekly email with Infinite Campus assignment reports, and targeted parent meetings at the 10 week grade report windows
- Parallel ELA/Math and Achieve Support Classes: targeted parent meetings at the 10 week grade report windows
- 9th and 10th Grade Check-In Survey (Academic, Social, Emotional): administrators and counselors identify 5 students each who would benefit from a Student Study Team intervention



Targeted Parent and Family Engagement Practices



- Intervention Referral for Late Start Wednesdays: require parent signature
- Office Open and Staffed to 4:15 (previously 3:30)
- Report Card Mailing (10 and 15 Week): mailing includes information beyond grades
- Mandatory Student Planners Grades 9-12
- Implemented Steering Committee: parents, teachers, students, admin and counselor (meet monthly)
