MARRIED/PREGNANT/PARENTING STUDENTS

The Governing Board recognizes that early marriage, pregnancy, or parenting may disrupt students' education and increase the chance of a student dropping out of school. The Board therefore, desires to provide instruction and services designed to assist in pregnancy prevention. The Board also desires to support pregnant and parenting students in attaining strong academic and parenting skills to promote the healthy development of their children.

(cf. 5149 At Risk Students)

Married, pregnant, and parenting students in the district shall have the same educational and extracurricular opportunities as all students. Participation in special programs or schools shall be voluntary.

(cf. 0410 - Nondiscrimination in District Programs and Activities) (cf. 5127 - Graduation Ceremonies and Activities) (cf. 6145 - Extracurricular and Cocurricular Activities)

In addition, for school-related purposes, married students under the age of 18 are emancipated minors and have all the rights and privileges of a student who is 18, even if the marriage has been dissolved. (Family Code 7002)
