RESOLUTION NO. 19/20-30

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE WILLIAM S. HART UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT DESIGNATING THE SUPERINTENDENT, CHIEF BUSINESS OFFICER, AND CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER AS THE DISTRICT'S AGENTS TO PROVIDE REQUIRED ASSURANCES AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF OBTAINING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (CAL OES) FOR DISASTER AID; APPROVING THE CORRESPONDING CAL OES FORM 130; AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF BUSINESS OFFICER TO EXECUTE AND FILE THE CAL OES FORM 130 AND SUBMIT ALL RELATED DOCUMENTATION

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2020, the President declared the ongoing Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant a major declaration for the State of California, pursuant to section 501 (b) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121-5207). State, Territorial, Tribal, local government entities and certain private non-profit (PNP) organizations are eligible to apply for Public Assistance; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 502 of the Stafford Act, eligible emergency protective measures taken to respond to the COVID-19 emergency at the direction or guidance of public health officials may be reimbursed under Category B of the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Public Assistance program; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) Recovery Section acts as the grantee for FEMA's Public Assistance program and is ready to assist potential applicants with applying for a Public Assistance subgrant and understanding eligibility requirements; and

WHEREAS, in order for Cal OES to complete processing the District's Request for Public Assistance, the Governing Board must designate District agents responsible for providing required assurances and executing agreements with FEMA and Cal OES on behalf of the District and approve the corresponding Cal OES Form 130; and

WHEREAS, District staff recommends that the form designate agents and be effective for all open and future disasters declared by the state or federal government up to three years following the date of approval so as to expedite processing of requests in the future; and

WHEREAS, District staff will request funding for costs not covered by the disaster aid, as part of the District's annual budget process for Fiscal Year 2019-20.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the William S. Hart Union High School District, that it hereby designates the Superintendent, Chief Business Officer, and Chief Administrative Officer as the District's agents to provide required assurances and execute agreements for the purposes of obtaining financial assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the State of California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) for disaster aid; approving Cal OES Form 130, attached to the Resolution as Exhibit A; and authorizing the Chief Business Officer to file the Cal OES Form 130 with Cal OES and submit all related documentation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and adoption.
