

**Addendum to 2020-21 SPSA for Sierra Vista Junior High**  
**Approved by SSC on 9/11/2020**  
**Submitted for Board approval on October 7, 2020**

**Goal 1.3:** All students will increase proficiency in both ELA and Math as measured by the California Dashboard.

**Books: \$2,500.00**

Need: These books will be of high interest to students and are much needed to update the SV library's collection which has an average age of 21 years in copyright dates. The CA state standard is that school library books should be of an average age no more than 15 years old in copyright date. Also, the state standard of book collection size is 20 books per student. We have increased enrollment from 1,057 to 1,120 this year, and have even fewer books per student (now - 14.58 books/student; last year 15.47 books/student). Therefore, we greatly need funds to maintain and improve our collection to replace worn and lost books, plus add new titles to inspire our students to read.

*Funding: Reallocate \$2,500.00 in unspent 2019-20 Title 1 funds*

**Goal 1.7:** All students will increase proficiency in both ELA and Math as measured by the California Dashboard.

**STEAM Materials: \$5,000.00**

Need: STEAM materials are needed to help supplement items that are already in our Practical Arts classroom. These items will be used by students to help support learning in all STEAM areas (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math). Students who enjoy working with their hands will find value in this class as well as help them stay engaged in school.

*Funding: Reallocate \$5,000 in unspent 2019-20 Title 1 funds*

**Goal 2.1:** EL, SPED, and SED students will increase proficiency and raise academic progress in ELA and Math as measured by the CA Dashboard.

**Homeless Supplies: \$2,500.00**

Need: Due to recent events in our community, as well as the COVID pandemic, we have noticed an increase in homeless families and students that are in need of more socio-economic support. Many students are in need of basic items as well as supplemental food and items needed for student well-being. By providing these resources, students will be able to focus on their studies and not their family struggles. These items will be distributed to needy students by our social workers.

*Funding: Reallocate \$2,500 in unspent 2019-20 Title I funds.*

**Goal 2.7** EL, SPED, and SED students will increase proficiency and raise academic progress in ELA and Math as measured by the CA Dashboard.

**Headphones: \$7,000.00**

Need: Due to recent events in our community, as well as the COVID pandemic, we are in need of more supplies to support our low income, EL and SPED students. These students are in need of additional resources to allow them to access their classrooms in this digital learning time. Students will benefit from using these headphones to be more active and engaged in their classes.

*Funding: Reallocate \$7,000.00 in unspent 2019-20 Title 1 funds*

**Goal 2.7** EL, SPED, and SED students will increase proficiency and raise academic progress in ELA and Math as measured by the CA Dashboard.

**Materials and Supplies: \$2,000.00**

Need: Due to recent events in our community, as well as the COVID pandemic, we are in need of more supplies to support our low income, EL and SPED students. These students are in need of additional resources to allow them to access their classrooms in this digital learning time. Students will benefit from supplemental materials for students to use upon their return to school.

*Funding: Reallocate \$2,000.00 in unspent 2019-20 Title 1 funds*

**Goal 3.6:** Increase all stakeholders' social, emotional, and academic wellness at Sierra Vista.

**Positive Student Wellness Supplies: \$6,000.00**

Need: Due to recent events in our community, as well as the COVID pandemic, we have noticed an increased need for social and emotional support to help students with wellness. Many students have definitely been affected by stress and trauma in the last year. Students' well-being needs shall be taken care of to support them socially and emotionally, help succeed academically, and build connectedness to school. We anticipate supporting the Unity to Community event, and purchasing supplies to support our student wellness program for when students return to campus.

*Funding: Reallocate \$6,000.00 in unspent 2019-20 Title 1 funds*

**Goal 4.1:** Increase student achievement in all academic classes to ensure more students are promoting onto high school.

**Homeless supplies: \$2,500.00**

Need: Due to recent events in our community, as well as the COVID pandemic, we have noticed an increase in homeless families and students that are in need of more socio-economic support. Many students are in need of basic items as well as supplemental food and items needed for student well-being. By providing these resources, students will be able to focus on their studies and not their family struggles. These items will be distributed to needy students by our social workers.

*Funding: Move additional money from 4.1 in the amount of \$2,500.00 due to Zoom being purchased through the district during the 2020-21 school year. Money should be reallocated to 2.1 for additional support for Homeless services.*
