- ◆ Mentor Training
- ◆ Hart District serving as liaison between BCCHS and California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (Cluster and State levels)
- ◆ Induction Academies leading to clearing of preliminary credentials, including advisement, portfolio analysis and seminars
- ◆ Analysis of induction credentials by Educator Preparation Program Specialist and Credentials Analyst
- ◆ Work completed for Induction by the candidate, including the ILP, may not be used for evaluative purposes by the employer.
- ◆ Recommendation of Clear credential upon satisfactory completion of requirements for Teacher Induction Inquiry (ILP) system
