## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### **“LPSBG”**

- AB 1808, Article 7
- Allocates \$300 million in State funds to increase student achievement for identified low performing students
- Receiving \$1,448,426
- Funding period 2018-19 through 2020-21

## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### Students Identified

- Standards Not Met / Nearly Not Met
- English CAASPP
- Math CAASPP
- Not already receiving additional services (EL, HL, FY, SED, SpEd)

## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### Students Identified

- 505 students (2017)
- 510 students (2018)
- No general trends or student groups
- Ethnicities & Grade levels balanced
- 42% White, 36% Hispanic, 10% Black, 18% Other
- Various school sites

- **Report #1 - *March 1, 2019***
  - Plan submission
- **Report #2 - *November 30, 2021***
  - Program evaluation

## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### Allowable Expenses - 3 Categories

- Professional Development for certificated staff
- Instructional Materials
- Other Support for Pupils

### **Proposed Expenditures**

- **Professional Development**
  - Differentiated Instruction
  - Response to Intervention
  - Reading and Writing Strategies
  - District by Design
  - Universal Design for Learning
  - Trauma Informed Practices

## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### **Proposed Expenditures**

- **Instructional Materials**
  - Reading Inventory
  - Individualized Computer Programs
  - Remedial Skills Practice

## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### **Proposed Expenditures**

- **Other Support for Pupils**
  - Wellness Centers - Staffing and Management
  - District Wellness / Intervention Coordinator
  - Site Wellness Liaisons
  - Increased Counseling Services

## **Low Performing Students Block Grant**

### **Expected Outcomes**

- Outcomes and activities for identified students will be reviewed annually to identify and address achievement gaps and their measure of academic progress.
